



Minor Head Injury
Warning Signs



Return to the Emergency Department if:

Unable to awaken your child or he/she seems more sleepy or confused.

Severe or worsening headache, or seizure.

Continued or worsening vomiting, fever, or neck stiffness.

Loses control of urine or stool

Weakness or numbness of the face or an arm or leg

Trouble walking, seems more unsteady
