Department If Your child is:

Your child is unable to take fluids or is weak sleepy, or lethargic.

Irritable, and it is difficult to calm him/her down.

Your child has other symptoms—rash, trouble breathing, ear pain, headache, stiff neck, vomiting, diarrhea, joint swelling, or pain.

You think your child looks dry (eyes look sunken, soft spot is depressed, no tears when crying, mouth looks dry).

You think your child looks sick or is getting worse.
